17th Annual Art Car Show and Art Car CARavan/Parade

DEADLINE: FRIDAY, MARCH 19, 2010

Artscape and the American Visionary Art Museum (AVAM) invite art car artists and all artists to be part of the annual Art Car Show and Art Car CARavan/Parade in Baltimore. Artscape will be offering commissions for the creation of new cars, bikes and other wheeled vehicles. Limited travel stipends will also be considered.

Artscape is produced by the Baltimore Office of Promotion & the Arts, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "BOPA" acting on behalf of the Baltimore Festival of the Arts, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "BFAI").

Guest Curator

This year, our guest curator is Holly Klemm. Holly brings great new ideas for Artscape 2010 and is a well-respected member of the local Art Car community. She has been involved with the Artscape Art Car Exhibit since 2001. Her on-site presence in previous years, helped build a stronger community amongst exhibitors and generated much enthusiasm with festival-goers.

Her car, Blue Hawaiian, continues to be an Art Car favorite.

Guidelines for New Cars, Local Cars and Travel Stipends

1. This exhibition is open to artists working anywhere.
2. Honoraria of up to \$500 will be awarded for the modification of cars. Final honoraria awards will be decided by the curator. It is also possible that a non-running car can be made available for modification.
3. Amount of travel stipends will be determined by the distance that the car is from the show and the funds available. Stipends will be limited and will not be available to all applicants.
4. If you are interested in participating or are planning to make an art car, you must fill out the attached application form.
5. New car modification applications should include a CD-Rom containing 5 jpeg images of recent work, one 8 ½ x 11" drawing of proposed piece, an optional one page written description of the proposed piece, a one page resume and a signed and filled out application and image description form. Image files should be labeled last name first, first name, number corresponding to the description sheet last. Each image should be sized at 72 dpi at approximately 12" x 16" or under 700 kb per image. No application materials will be returned.

6. For out of area travel stipends, a CD-Rom with images of the car and the application form should be submitted. CD files should conform to the above standards.
7. Artscape reserves the right to reproduce images of selected artwork for printed or internet publicity, catalogue or marketing purposes.

Custom Postcards for Exhibitors: The first 10 exhibitors who specify that they will be on site for the entire three day weekend, will have an image of their car printed on an oversize 2010 Artscape/Art Car postcard to share with their fans. Exhibitors must supply BOPA with an unobstructed, high resolution photo of their vehicle, with their submitted application.

New for 2010 – The Art Car Lounge

Artist Renee Tantillo will design and create seating constructed from car parts and car seats. The Art Car Lounge will be in a tented area located near the car exhibit for use by the exhibitors and public.
