**The 29<sup>th</sup> annual Artscape:** July 16 – 18, 2010

Artscape is now accepting submissions for performance consideration. Dancers/Troops must live in one of the following areas to be considered: Maryland; Washington, DC; Delaware; Arlington, Alexandria, Fairfax or Loudoun Virginia; and Adams, Chester, Franklin, Lancaster or York Pennsylvania.

The Lyric Opera House will be under renovation this summer, so it will not be available for Dance at Artscape. However, we invite dancers and dance companies to submit proposals for creative 15 – 20 minute site specific performances for indoor or outdoor venues. Possible indoor venues include the stage at Falvey Hall in the Brown Center, the Theatre Project stage and the lobby of the Meyerhof Symphony Hall. Considering that the venues for dance will be significantly smaller with fewer amenities we ask that performances be limited to those that require ten dancers/performers or less.

If the committee is interested in booking your group, you will be contacted to explore the feasibility of a particular day and time. Details of compensation will be negotiated at the time of booking.
