COMIC STRIP: Penn Station Windows *and Comic Strips for Kids under 16 at Target Family Art Park.* **Comics, Illustration, Photo Novellas and Graphic Novels**

DEADLINE: FRIDAY, May 21, 2010

Show duration, July 16 - 19

Comic Strip will be an exhibition of comics, illustrations, photo novellas, graphic novels or works which follow the basic format presentation of comic strips. Artists are invited to submit works for consideration that will complement this format and transform individual 8 ½" x 11" paned windows into comic strip "panels".

Comic Strip will be part of Artscape 2010 and will be located at Penn Station in Baltimore. The exhibition space will utilize an 8' x45' bank of windows outside the station at Charles Street, near the popular Midway exhibit.

Artscape 2010 is in its 29th year and is the nation's largest free arts festival. Hundreds of thousands of visitors attend Artscape each year, many of which will experience this exhibit. Artscape is produced by the Baltimore Office of Promotion & the Arts, Inc. on behalf of the Baltimore Festival of the Arts, Inc.

Application Materials

Entries can be emailed, hand-delivered or submitted by mail. Submissions should include either a CD-Rom containing the scanned artwork or 8 ½" x 11" printed copies of the individual panel art. **Original art can not be returned.**

Guidelines

1. Artists over the age of 16, living anywhere are eligible to submit works.
2. Submissions should be 8 ½" x 11" (**vertically oriented**) and should be designed or reproduced to fit the space provided by each window. Artists may submit multiple submissions of up to six panels each.
3. Art will be presented in a left to right orientation, with each 8 ½" x 11" window serving as the equivalent of a single comic strip panel.
4. The title of the submitted comic strip and the artists name should be included somewhere within one of the panels.

5. If emailing, please send as PDF or jpg, up to 5mb per panel with each panel ready to print full size, 8 ½" x 11"—vertically oriented.

5. Artscape reserves the right to reproduce included submissions for publicity, website, catalogue and/or marketing purposes.

Comic Strip for Kids Under 16

In addition to Comic Strips at Penn Station, we will also open submissions to kids under the age of 16 to show their work at the Target Family Art Park, located across from the Meyerhoff Symphony Hall.

Submission guidelines are the same. However, multiple panels can be created on a single 8 ½ " x 11" submission and vertically or horizontally oriented works can be accepted for Comic Strip for Kids.
